### The 3. Ukrainian Economic Forum

The introduction of the "green" tariff in Ukraine in 2009 and the entry into The European Energy Community in September 2010 are important steps on the way of modernization and improvement of the energy sector of Ukraine. The Third Ukrainian Business Forum will take place in Berlin at the 20 – 21th of June 2011 on the territory of largest Tehnopark in Germany "Adlershof".

The central topics of the Forum are alternative energy, energy conservation and efficiency in a municipal infrastructure. The development of bioenergy sector is the further principal direction. Investments into pilot projects of solar, geothermal and wind energy development are planned. Furthermore, the water energy possesses a big potential. It is necessary to use modern technologies in such areas as heat supply and heat distribution, water supply and recycling, e.g., treatment facilities, renovation of the water drain and pipelines.

The area of recycling of dust and hard household wastes requires improvement and modernization. The implementation of waste storages, incineration plants and modernization of dust gathering systems are highly recommended.

During the Forum participants will have the possibility to share experiences and gain new information and proposals according the alternative energy and energy efficiency, municipal and housing infrastructure. With the help of talks between participants we hope to favour the introduction of the European experience and technologies into projects represented by the Ukrainian party. Also they will accent on real possibilities of investment into projects and their realization. Working language is German. Simultaneous interpretation on German, Russian and Ukrainian.

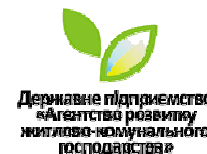
